RISE and HOP Program Guidelines

If you are chosen for a scholarship award, you must abide by the following program guidelines:

- 1. BE HERE! Awardees must be present during the entire program period and the activities are to be completed by May 31, 2015.
- 2. TELL US WHO YOU ARE and IF THIS PROGRAM MADE A SIGNIFICANT IMPACT ON YOUR EDUCATION OR CAREER TRAJECTORY! Per NASA requirements, Scholarship recipients are required to provide information through periodic surveys from Nevada Space Grant or NASA representatives for 5 years after the scholarship period. (This helps us learn the value of these programs and is important to continued NASA funding of Space Grant programs!)
- 3. TELL US WHAT YOU DID! Each student must prepare and present an oral <u>or</u> poster presentation for the Nevada Undergraduate Research Symposium, Undergraduate Research Summer Poster Session <u>or</u> for the Nevada NASA EPSCoR and Space Grant Annual Meeting. (The poster or presentation should represent the research/project effort performed over the course of the funded project period. You can receive guidance from your Mentor on this.)
- 4. AWARD ACCEPTANCE! Upon notification of receiving an award, each awardee will be required to submit the following documents via the link provided or via e-mail to nvspacegrant@nshe.nevada.edu:

 - b. Student profile form https://www.research.net/r/SGStudentProfile2015-2016
 - c. Digital photograph of awardee
 - d. Abstract of the project
 - e. Brief biography (no more than ½ page)
- 5. MAINTAIN YOUR GOOD STANDING AS A FULL TIME STUDENT! Each awardee must maintain good student standing to be eligible for a second semester of support. Semester grades must be submitted electronically at the end of the fall 2015 semester to nvspacegrant@nshe.nevada.edu.
