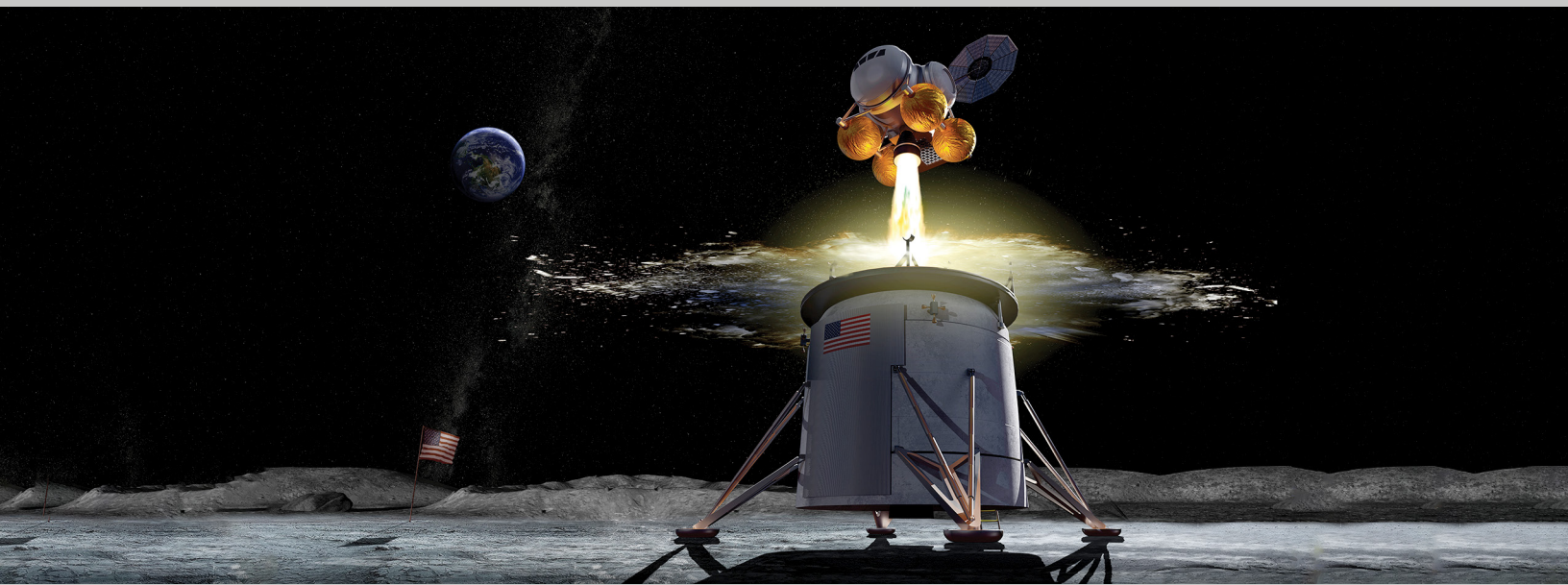


# Are you a college student?

## 1 ACCEPT THE CHALLENGE

**LEARN** about the Artemis Mission and the technologies NASA needs. Students at Minority Serving Institutions (MSIs): submit a proposal for \$1,500 for your project. Faculty at MSIs receive a \$1,000 stipend for mentoring a team. **APPLY** to participate!

**PLAN** your detailed design concept, utilizing trade off analysis, simulated failure analysis, and computer simulations.

## 3 MAKE IT HAPPEN

**BUILD** your project and show it off to NASA Subject Matter Experts. Present your posters and technical papers at renowned conferences.
